The program is free of charge and can be downloaded with or without installation.


It's possible to install the program on a smartphone or on PC.

- The next screen appears:




- Click on the button Download Now.




Now it's already possible to use Anydesk. But if you use Anydesk like this, you will have to do all the steps before every time you want to use Anydesk. We will install

- The next screen appears:




- Click on the button Accept & Install.




1.3 HOW TO USE ANYDESK?

- Ask the number of the device you want to take over. This can be done by phone for example. The number is visible in the left corner of the screen.




 Enter the number of the device that you want to take over in the field unther Remote Desk.




• Click on the button Connect.
